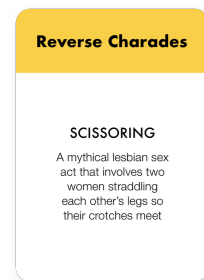


GET KNOTTY RULES

How to get started



Action card



Monster card

There are 2 decks of cards.

- 1. Actions cards:** The one with prompts
- 2. Monster cards:** Playing cards with little monsters on them

Make sure both the decks are shuffled before you start playing. Start by distributing 5 monster cards to each player and place the Action cards at the centre of the table.

How to play

WINNING

To win the game you must be the first one to get rid of all your Monster cards.

PLAYING

Pick an Action card from the centre of the table and complete the prompt successfully to earn the right to discard a Monster Card.

If you don't want to complete the task, you must draw a Monster card from the spare Monster deck

TYPES OF ACTION CARDS

There are four types of Action cards. Make sure to call out the type of the card after you draw it.



Red One

Lucky Guess

Each card has 2 options A or B. Read the question to the group and let each player make a decision (Do not disclose it yet). As the task performer, you must guess which option (A or B) is the majority in the group. After your final answer, the players must reveal their answer to everyone using their AorB card.

For Lucky Guess, if there are an even number of players, DON'T include yourself in the count. If there are an odd number of players, DO include yourself in the count.



Green One

Share of Dare

Share an honest answer to what the prompt asks you or do the dare.



Blue One

Knotty Pics

Draw to describe the word written on the card. You cannot write numbers or words! You must get someone in the group to guess the word in under 1 min.



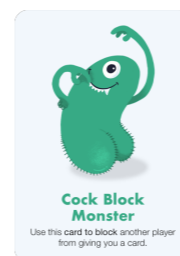
Yellow One

Reverse Charades

This card has a yellow back. You CANNOT see the prompt but show it to the group. The group should act it out to you and you need to guess the word in under a 1 min.

TYPES OF MONSTER CARDS

There are five types of Monster cards. All cards can be played on the discard pile but some have special skills.



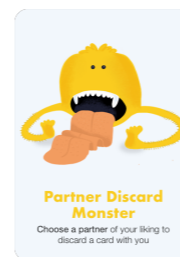
Cock Block Monster

This can be used to block a Sexually Transmitted Monster Card. You must discard this card if you play it.



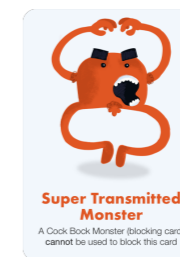
Double Discard

Discard 2 Monster cards! Woop Woop! You CANNOT transmit a card to another player on double discard.



Partner Discard Monster

Choose a player of your liking to discard a Monster card along with you. They (partner) CANNOT transmit a card to another player on this turn.



Super Transmitted Monster

This card can be given to another player of your choice or played as a normal card. This CANNOT be blocked by a Cock Block Monster.



Sexually Transmitted Monster

This card can be given to another player of your choice or played as a normal card. If cock blocked, then discard the STM card and draw a new card from the Monster deck



Basic Monster

This card has no special powers. This is played as a normal card in the deck.
